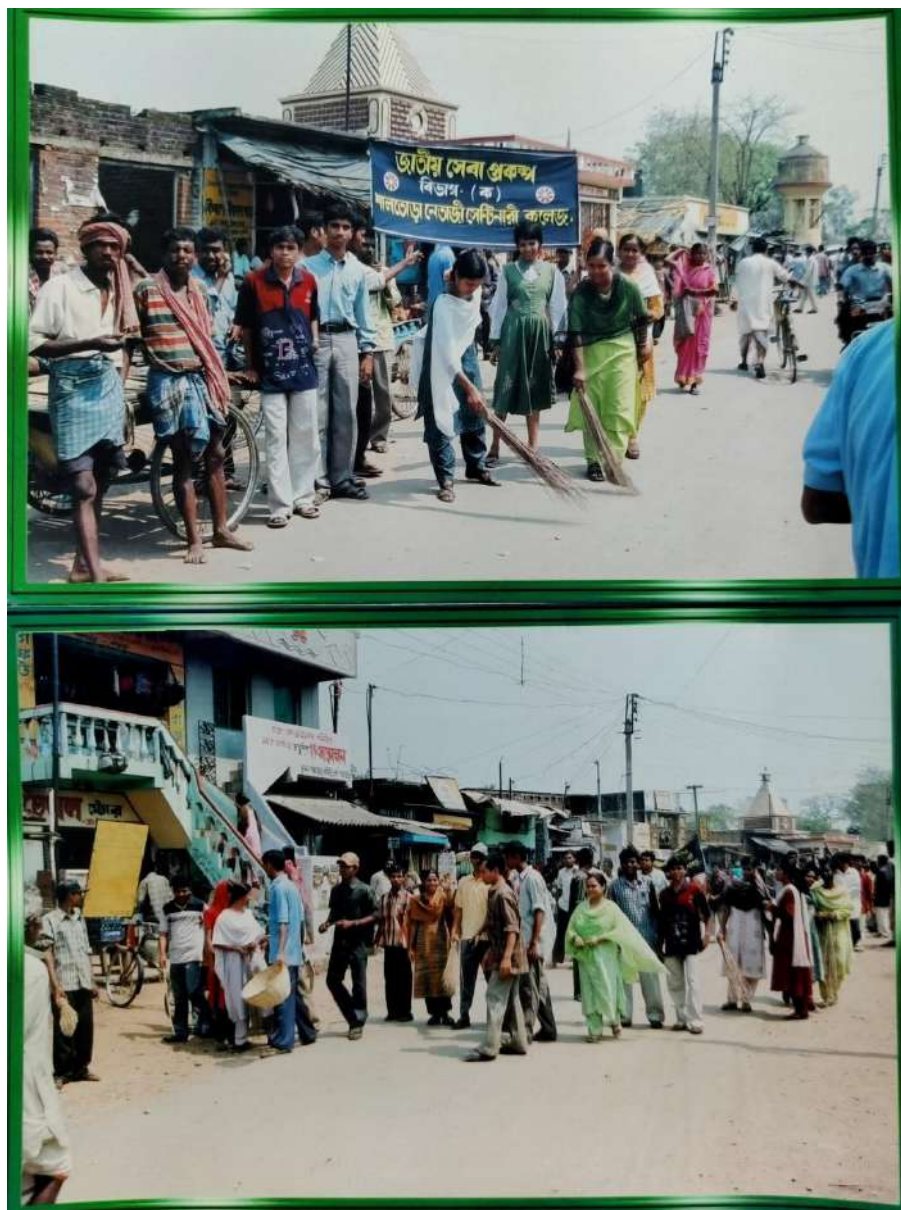
## 9. Tree plantation programme at the nearby wasteland (Bamnisala) on 27.12.2019

### Report:

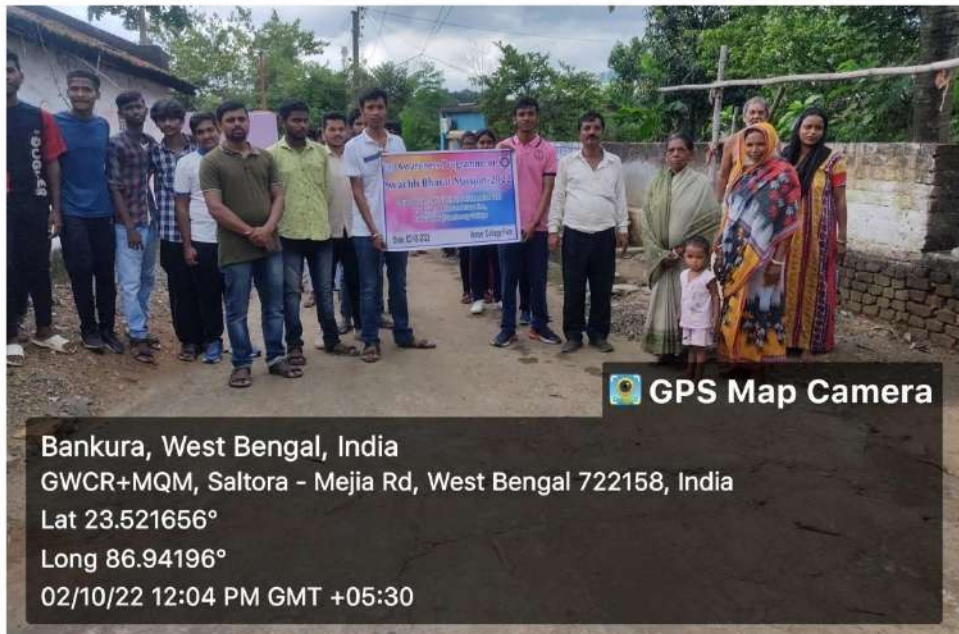

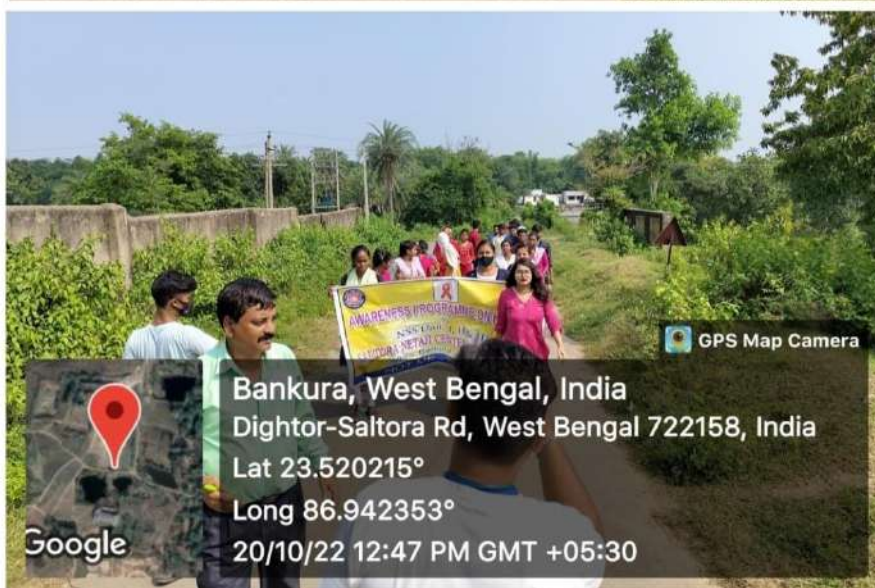
## 26. Awareness Campaign on Swachh Bharat Mission on 02.10.2022

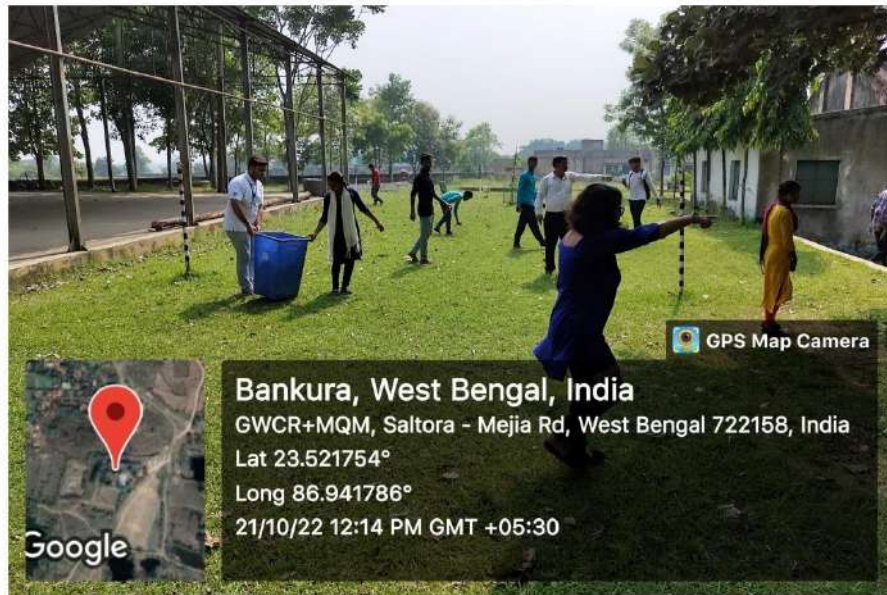
## 24. Awareness Programme on HIV/AIDS (By the Red Ribbon Club) (20.10.2022)

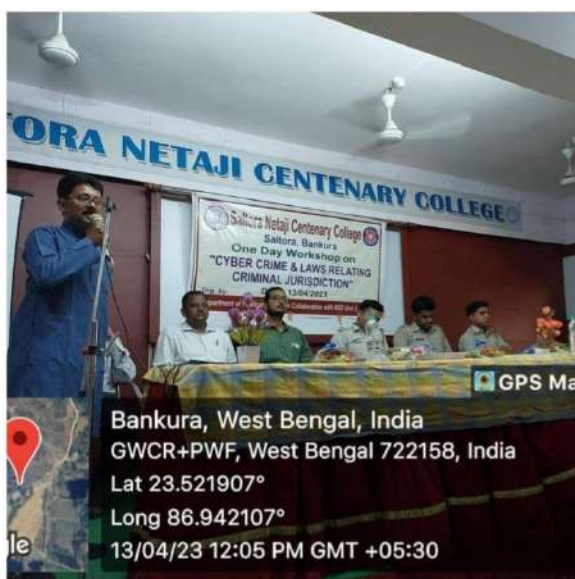
## 36. Free Eye Check-up Camp on 12.04.2023

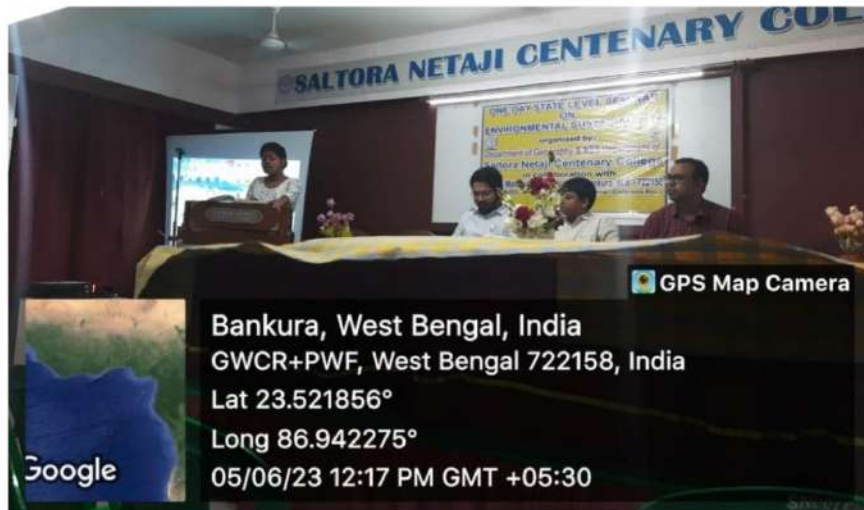
## 47. Beyond the Campus Environmental Promotion & Sustainability Activity (05.06.2023)

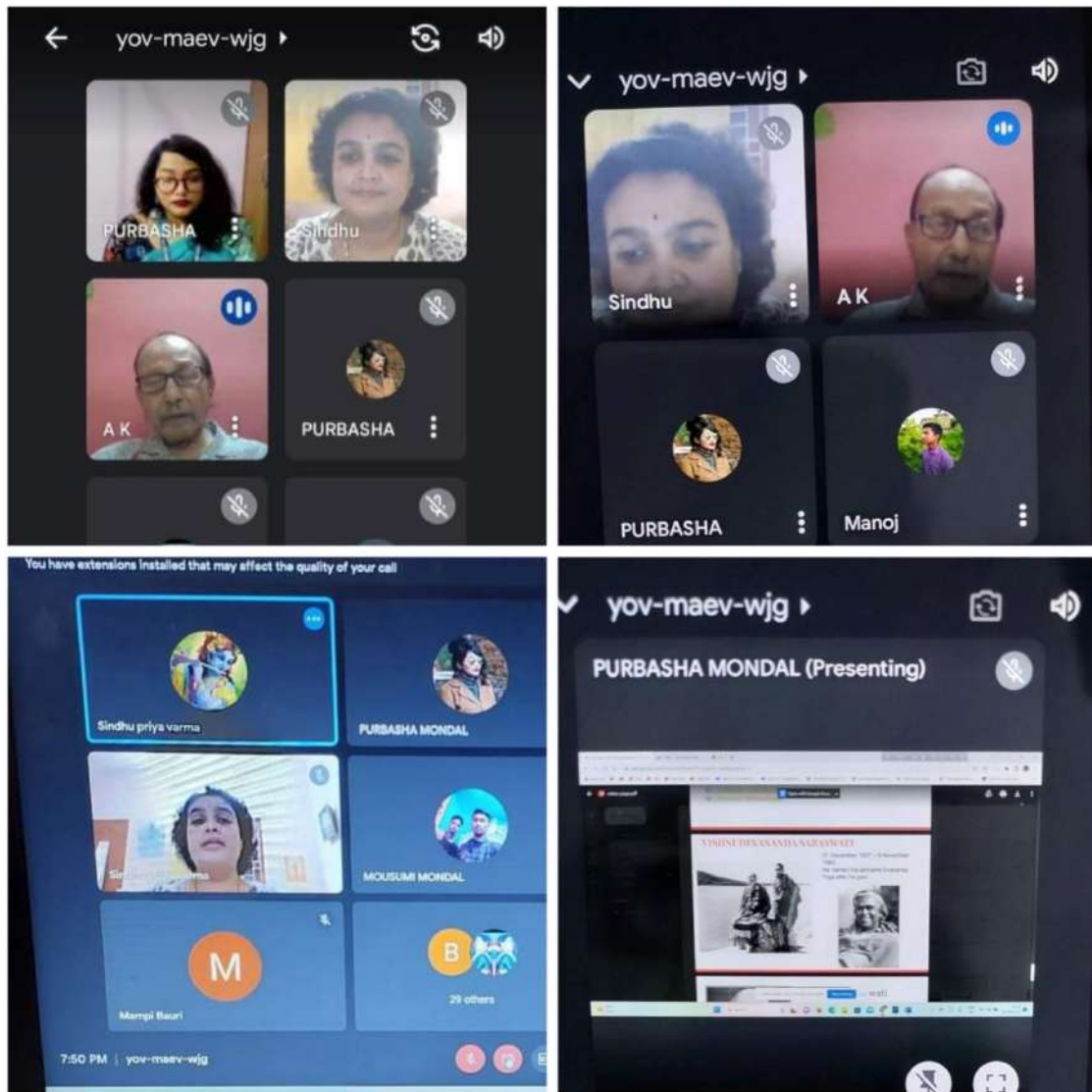


## **Report:**

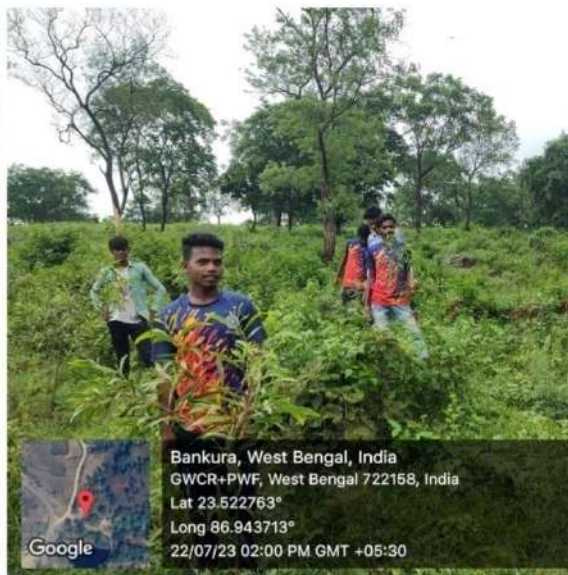
53. 'MeraMatiMeraDesh' programme on 17.07.2023
